Those two students who are chosen will present their speech along with a one minute impromptu speech at the NSW Primary Schools Multicultural Perspectives Public Speaking Competition. More information will be given to those students chosen throughout the term. Students are to hand their speeches to their classroom teacher by Monday 9 March (Week 7). Students will be presenting their speeches in class over the course of that week.
